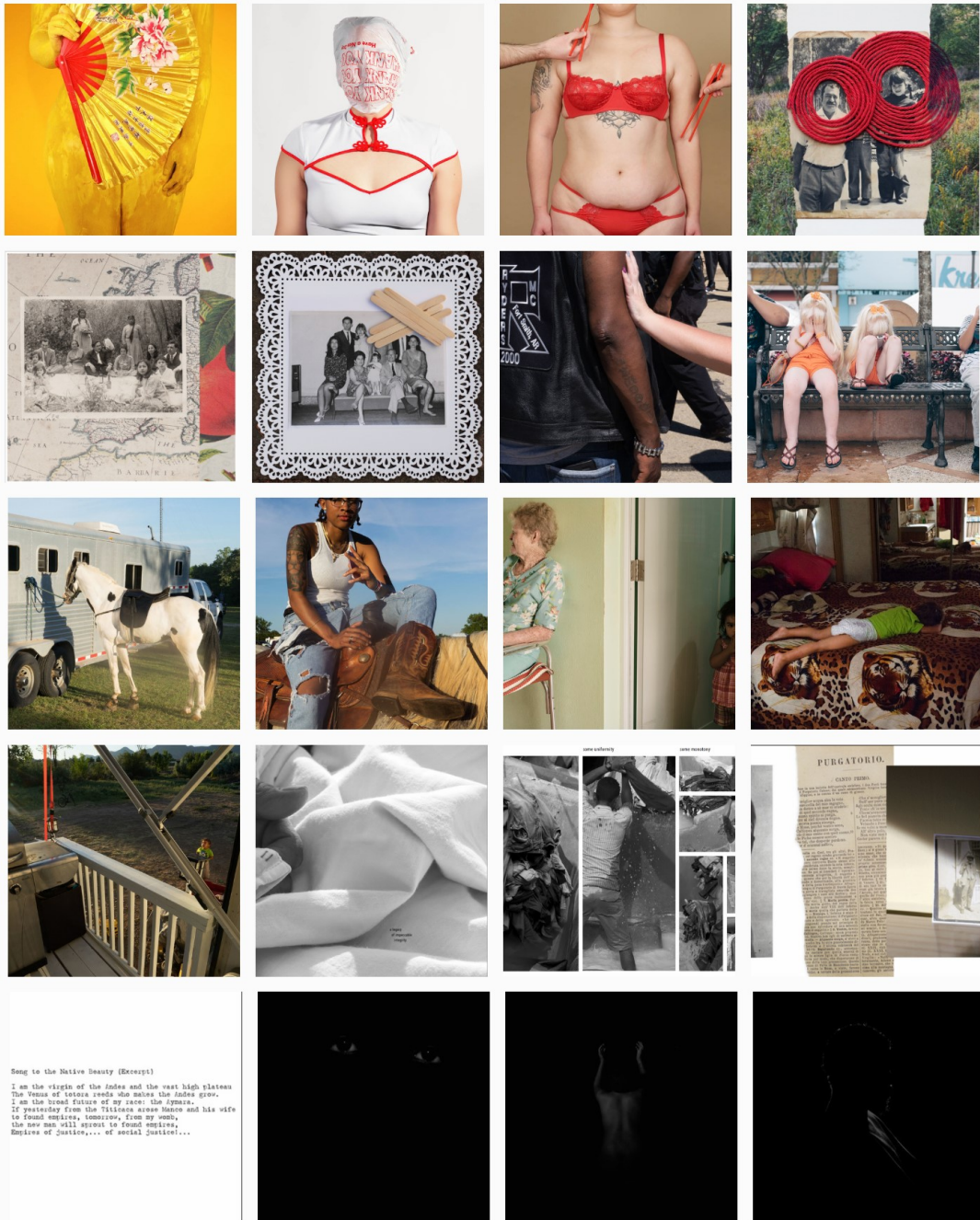
## JURIED ONLINE GROUP EXHIBITION
